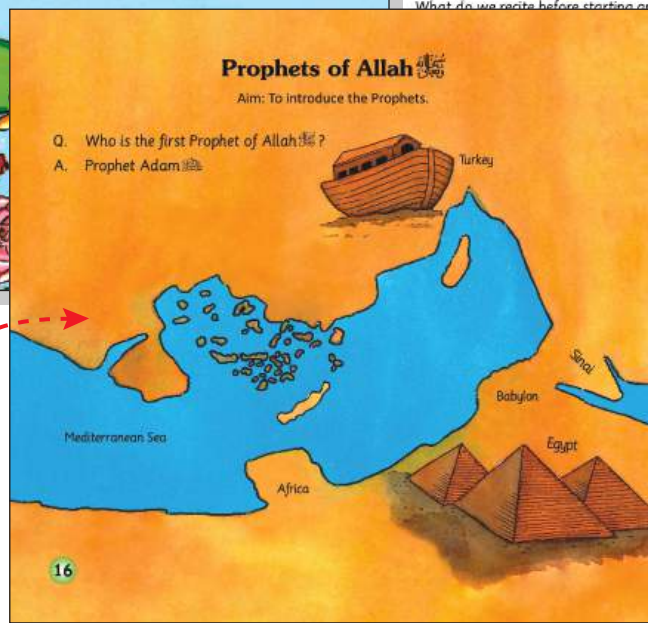
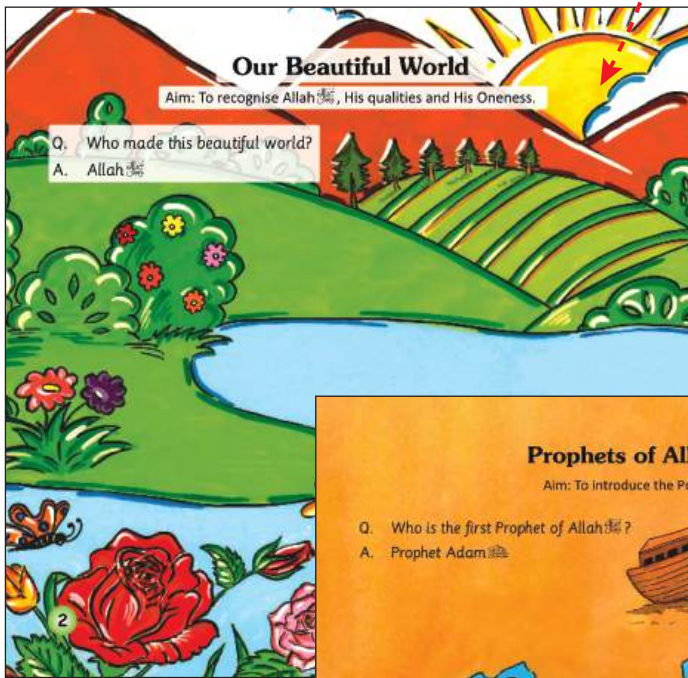
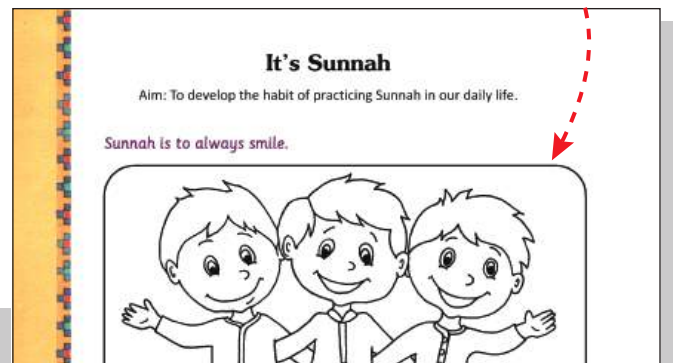
## Pre-Primary Year 1 – Year 3

### Islamic Months

Aim: To introduce and memorise the names of Islamic months.

Q. How many months are there in the Islamic calendar?  
A. There are twelve months in the Islamic calendar.

Q. Name the Islamic months.  
A. 1 Muharrum 2 Safar 3 Rabi-ul-Awwal 4 Rabi-us-Saani 5 Jamadi-ul-Awwal 6 Jamadi-us-Saani 7 Shabaan 8 Ramadan 9 Shawwal 10 Zill-Qadh 11 Zill-Hajj

Q. In which month do we celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr?  
A. We celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr in the month of Shawwal.

Q. In which month do we offer sacrifice?  
A. We offer sacrifice in the month of Zill-Hajj.

Teacher's Note: Ask the children to memorise the names of the Islamic months and the different events which fall in these months. For example, the month of fasting, the month in which the Islamic calendar begins etc.

### Stealing

Aim: To keep the children away from bad deeds.

Q. Is it right to take someone's things without permission?  
A. No! This is stealing.

Q. If we like someone's belongings, should we steal it?  
A. No! We should never steal anything.

Q. What will happen to those who steal?  
A. Allah ﷻ will send them into the Hell.

What will you do if you find someone's belongings in the classroom?

**THINK ABOUT**

Teacher's Note: Explain in detail about stealing. For example, taking things from someone's bag without permission, snatch something from someone or keep things without permission etc., all these are forms of stealing and Allah ﷻ will severely punish the thief.

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### Cleanliness

Aim: To develop the habit of cleanliness.

Q. What kind of children does Allah ﷻ like?  
A. Allah ﷻ likes neat and clean children.

Q. What we should do to keep ourselves clean?  
A. We should take bath daily, brush our teeth and wear clean clothes.

Q. What happens if we do not keep ourselves clean?  
A. We become ill if we do not keep ourselves clean.

**Activity** Make a dustbin for the classroom...

Teacher's Note: Encourage children to throw rubbish in the dustbin and keep the classroom clean. The teacher should inspect their uniform, shoes, nails and hair regularly.

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Guidelines for teachers and parents help to facilitate discussions.

### Sunnah is looking after your neighbours.

Teacher's Note: Tell the children that everything and actions done in the Sunnah. Enforce them to practice these Sunnah in everyday life.

Aim: To give the introduction of the last Prophet of Allah ﷻ.

Q. What is the name of our last Prophet?  
A. ﷺ Prophet Muhammad

Q. Where and when was ﷺ Prophet Muhammad born?  
A. He was born in Makkah Mukarramah in the month of Rabi-ul-Awwal.

Q. What kind of deeds did ﷺ Prophet Muhammad do?  
A. He always did good deeds.

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Engaging activities will help to develop the interest in learning.
