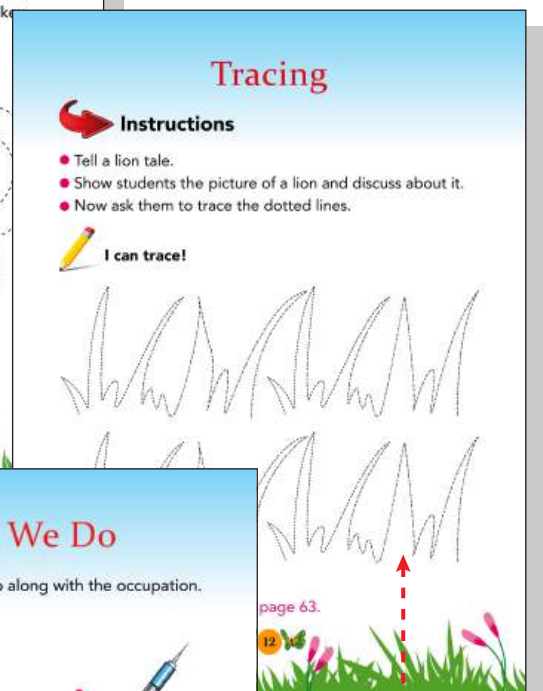
# Colours of Knowledge

## Pre-Primary Year 1 – Year 3

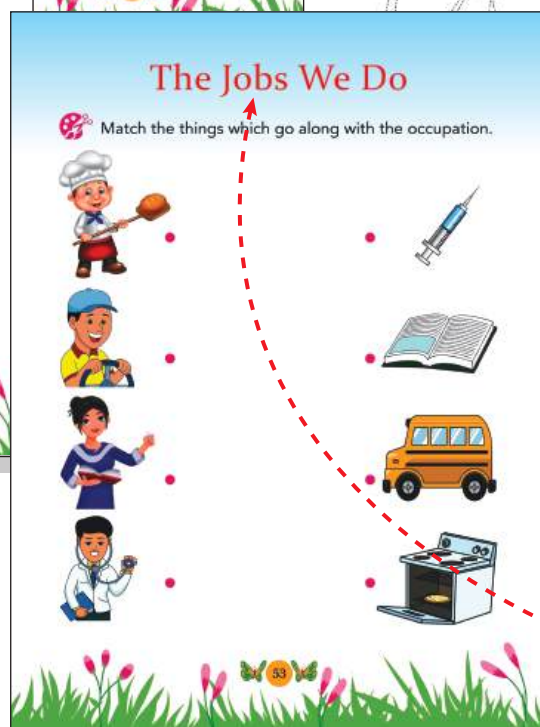
