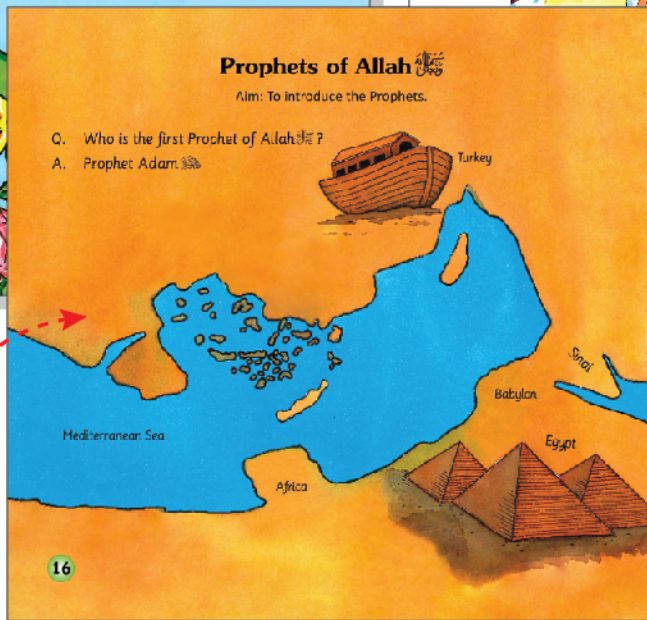
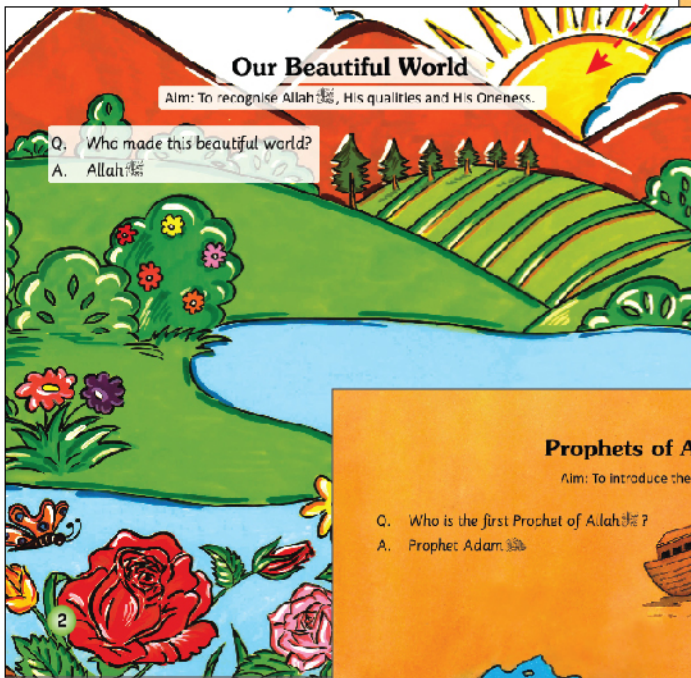
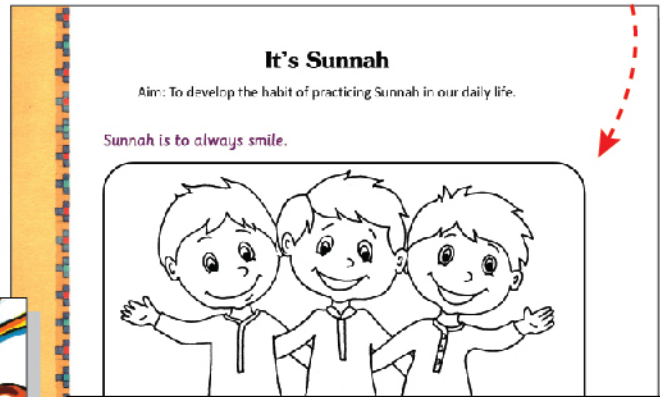
Pre-Primary Year 1 – Year 3

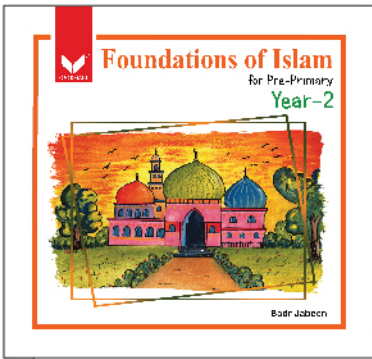

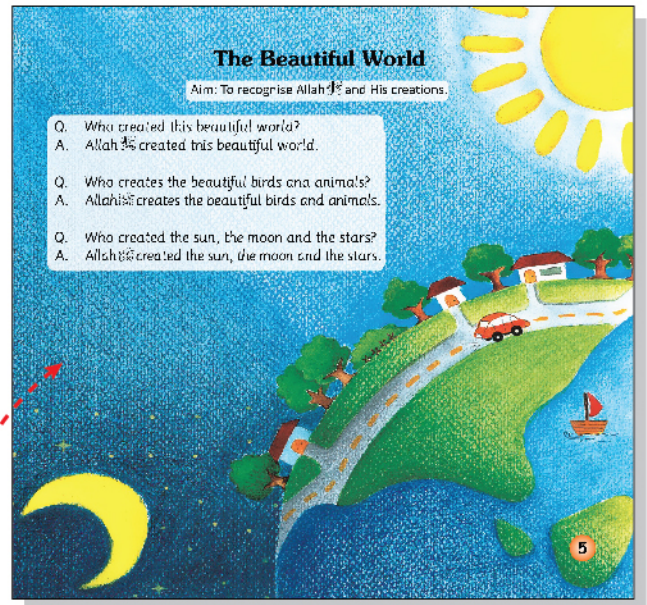

Aim: To recognise Allah ﷻ and His creations.

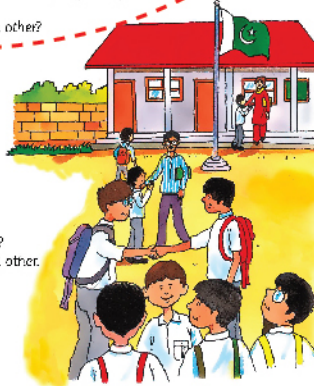
- Q. Who created this beautiful world?
A. Allah ﷻ created this beautiful world.
- Q. Who creates the beautiful birds and animals?
A. Allah ﷻ creates the beautiful birds and animals.
- Q. Who created the sun, the moon and the stars?
A. Allah ﷻ created the sun, the moon and the stars.

Muslims Greetings

Aim: To teach the Islamic way of greeting.

- Q. What do we say when we meet each other?
A. We say **السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ**.
- Q. What does **السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ** mean?
A. It means "peace be upon you".
- Q. What do we say in reply?
A. In reply, we say **وَعَلَيْكُمْ السَّلَامُ**.
- Q. What does **وَعَلَيْكُمْ السَّلَامُ** mean?
A. It means "peace be upon you too".
- Q. What happens when we say **السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ**?
A. It increases respect and love for each other.



Hadith-e-Nabawi
"Greet each other by saying **السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ**."
(Sahih Muslim)

Teacher's Note: Explain the children at various times and in various occasions say **السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ**. For example, when entering the classroom, home, when meeting elders, friends, as ams and teachers, when waking up in the morning, etc. Also care on the start of the activities.

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Quranic Surah

Aim: To read and memorise the Quranic Surah.

Surat-Al-Kausar

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

In the name of Allah, the Most Beneficent, the Most Merciful.

(O Muhammad) We gave you Kausar.
Therefore offer prayer for your Lord and sacrifice.
Surely! Your enemy will suffer the worse.

Teacher's Note: Ask children to read and memorise this Surah by heart. Explain also tell them the Kausar is a stream in Heaven.

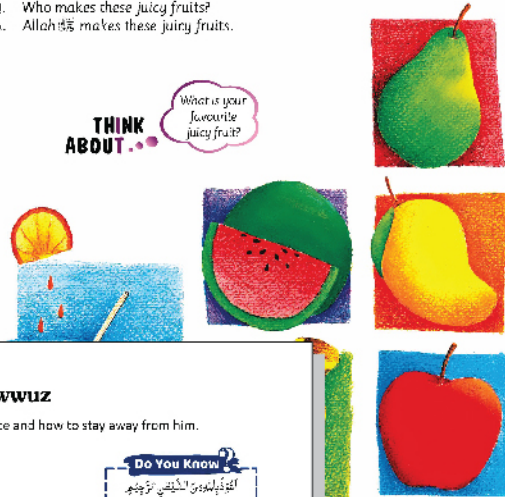

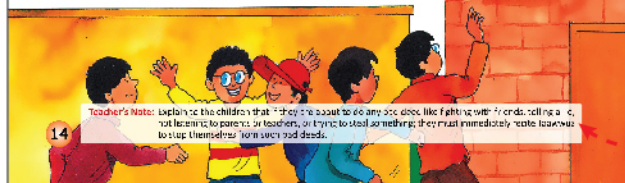


Taawwuz

Aim: To recognise Satan's existence and how to stay away from him.

- Q. Who is Satan?
A. Satan is our enemy.
- Q. What does Satan want?
A. Satan wants us to do bad things.
- Q. What will happen if we follow Satan?
A. Allah ﷻ will punish us.
- Q. What we should recite to keep Satan away?
A. We should recite **أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ**.
- Q. What happens when we recite **أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ**?
A. Satan stays away from us.

Do You Know?
أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ means, "I seek refuge with Allah from the accursed Satan."

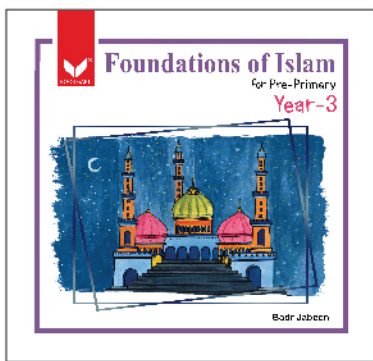


Teacher's Note: Explain to the children that "They're about to do any bad thing like fighting with friends, telling a lie, not listening to parents or teachers, or trying to steal or misbehave; they must immediately recite **أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ** to stop themselves from such bad deeds."

Islamic Months

Aim: To introduce and memorise the names of Islamic months.

Q. How many months are there in the Islamic calendar?
A. There are twelve months in the Islamic calendar.

Q. Name the Islamic months.

A. 1 Muharram	5 Jamadi-ul-Awwal	9 Ramazan
2 Safar	6 Jamadi-us-Saani	10 Shawwal
3 Rabi-ul-Awwal	7 Rajah	11 Zill-Qadh
4 Rabi-us-Saani	8 Shabaan	12 Zill-Hajj

Q. In which month do we celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr?
A. We celebrate Eid-ul-Fitr in the month of Shawwal.

Q. In which month do we offer sacrifice?
A. We offer sacrifice in the month of Zill-Hajj.

Teacher's Note: Ask the children to memorise the names of the Islamic months and the different events which fall in these months. For example, the month of fasting, the month in which the Islamic calendar begins etc.

Stealing

Aim: to keep the children away from bad deeds.

Q. Is it right to take someone's things without permission?
A. No! This is stealing.

Q. If we like someone's belongings, should we steal it?
A. No! We should never steal anything.

Q. What will happen to those who steal?
A. Allah (ﷻ) will send them into the Hell.

What will you do if you find someone's belongings in the classroom?

THINK ABOUT

Teacher's Note: Encourage children to avoid stealing. For example, taking things from someone's bag without permission, watch something from someone's mobile phone without permission etc. All these are bad character traits and Allah (ﷻ) will severely punish the thief.

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Cleanliness

Aim: To develop the habit of cleanliness.

Q. What kind of children does Allah (ﷻ) like?
A. Allah (ﷻ) likes neat and clean children.

Q. What we should do to keep ourselves clean?
A. We should take bath daily, brush our teeth and wear clean clothes.

Q. What happens if we do not keep ourselves clean?
A. We become ill if we do not keep ourselves clean.

Activity: Make a chart for the classroom.

Teacher's Note: Encourage children to take regular bath, dust and keep the classroom clean. The teacher should inspect their uniforms, shoes etc. in a friendly way.

A. He was born in Makkah Mukarramah in the month of Rabi-ul-Awwal.

Q. What kind of deeds did ﷺ Prophet Muhammad (ﷺ) do?
A. He always did good deeds.
